“We wanted to awaken a historic building from its slumber, without compromising on its authenticity,” says Daniel Erne of his bed and breakfast, Pontisella, in Stampa, Switzerland. He has brought new life into the typical Grisons home with its symmetrical façade, wrought-iron balconies and green shutters. Retaining its 1849 exterior, the inside mixes original features with warm, contemporary touches. The four guest rooms are furnished with alpine wood panelling, concrete floors and futon-style beds, while communal spaces combine stone fireplaces and pendant lights. The highlight here is breakfast, which Erne prepares using cured meats from a Stampa butcher, Latteria Bregaglia dairy products and eggs from his own chickens. — AW
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
